

ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

In the absence of School Committee policy specifically covering an action that the Superintendent feels he/she must take for the orderly execution of his/her duties, he/she may take temporary action. The action should be in harmony with overall School Committee policy and in keeping with the best established practice that can be determined under existing time constraints. The Superintendent will not be free to act when the action involves a School Committee duty which by law cannot be delegated.

In each case in which the Superintendent takes such initiative action, he/she will present the matter to the School Committee at its next meeting, so the members may conduct the proper review and consider the need for policy adoption in the given area(s).
