

SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

Principalship

Acting with the approval of the Superintendent and upon the advice of Central Office administrators, each principal will be the chief administrator of his/her school. All personnel assigned to his/her building will be directly responsible to him/her. Staff members who work in more than one school will be responsible to the principal of the school during the time they are working in his/her building.

The principal is charged with the supervision and direction of the staff and the students assigned to his/her building, and with care of the school facility and its equipment. He/she will see that District policies, rules, and regulations, the directives of District officers, and the guidelines for the instructional program are observed. Within the framework of School Committee policies and the general rules and regulations set by the Superintendent, the principal may establish and enforce such additional regulations as he/she deems advisable for the efficient operation of his/her school.
