

POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent has responsibility for carrying out, through administrative regulations, the policies established by the School Committee.

There are many activities that are common to all departments and school levels, but procedures for conducting them may vary from unit to unit. Principals and department heads will establish procedures for conducting activities within their individual units within the larger framework of administrative regulations and School Committee policies.

The policies developed by the School Committee and the administrative regulations developed to implement policy are designed to increase the probability of an effective and efficient school system. Consequently, all School Department employees and students will willingly carry them out.

Employees in superordinate positions are responsible for informing subordinates of existing policies and regulations and for seeing that they are implemented in the spirit intended. Continuous disregard for School Committee policy and administrative regulations will be interpreted as willful neglect of duty.
