

STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

Printed material that conflicts with the basic educational mission of the schools, that may be inappropriate for young audiences, or that may be reasonably judged by the public to bear the imprimatur of the Windham School Department, shall not be distributed on or in school property.

In the event a school principal determines that there is or may be a violation of any part of this policy, the principal shall immediately notify the Superintendent of Schools, or designee, and the distributor(s) of the printed material and request that the distribution cease. The decision of the principal may be appealed to the Superintendent of Schools, or designee, who shall promptly meet with the distributor(s) for the purpose of determining whether or not there has been a violation of any part of this policy and who shall deliver a decision to the distributor(s) within one (1) school working day.
