

PARENT INVOLVEMENT WITH TITLE I

For the purpose of strengthening the Title I program, Title I administrators and staff must comply with the following provisions:

- A. Prompt notification that a child has been selected for Title I services, the reasons for the decision, and requesting the parent's signature to allow the district to work with the child.
- B. At the request of a parent, test results will be reviewed to clarify the information.
- C. Specific instructional objectives for the child will be discussed with the parent.
- D. Parents will receive regular reports on their child's progress.
- E. Parents will receive training, materials, and suggestions to help them promote the education of their children at home.
- F. Parents' suggestions in the planning, development, and operation of the program will be solicited.
- G. Parents' recommendations will be responded to in a timely manner.
- H. Participation by parents in school activities will be encouraged; and
- I. Parent coordinators will be designated and parent advisory councils will be established.

The end-of-the-year report to the School Board and to State Title I officials shall include to what extent these provisions were accomplished.
