MINUTES OF JANUARY 10, 2007

WORKSHOP MEETING

Members of the Windham School Board met for a Workshop Meeting on January 10, 2007, immediately following a Special Meeting, in the Conference Room at Town Hall. Drug & Alcohol Policy (JFCD)

Windham High School Assistant Principal, Kelli Martin, explained the Administration's request that this policy include the words "attempting to sell/furnish." After discussion, the Board asked that this go back to the Policy Committee to consider using "soliciting," rather than "attempting."

Update on School Lunch Program – Swipe Cards

School Lunch Director, Sharon Dixon, and Bob Hickey, Coordinator – District Technology / Project Manager, shared with the Board how the new swipe card system has been working and information on the lunch program finances.

Vocational School Budgets

The Board reviewed the proposed 2007 – 2008 budgets from the Portland Arts & Technology High School (PATHS) and the Westbrook Regional Vocational School (WRVC). They asked Superintendent Prince to bring them back more information on how the budget figures were calculated. Once they review the additional information, they will vote on the two budgets.
