Athletic Funding Proposal, Part 2

Athletic Director Steve Merrill presented to the Board a proposal to phase into the School Department budget those extracurricular sports teams that are currently being supported solely by students and parents. Mr. Merrill provided information on costs for current school teams and the number of students participating, along with information on the student/parent-sponsored teams. Mr. Merrill will come back to the Board in the next couple of months with a more detailed plan.

Health Curriculum Update

Director of Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment, Christopher Howell, along with members of the Health Curriculum Committee, reported to the Board the work that has gone into developing the current health curriculum and how explained how it is aligned with the Maine Learning Results.
