Happy New Year Windham High School

It is hard to believe that we are almost half way done with the school year. The past few months have gone by so quickly with the many exciting events that have taken place. January is going to be a busy month with midterm exams taking place and the start of the registration process for next school year.

Midterm exams will begin on January 17th and will end on January 20th. Each of the midterm exam days will consist of two exams in the morning and a make-up and extra help session in the afternoon. (Please see the official exam schedule in this newsletter) Exams for Blocks 1 and 2 will be on Tuesday, 3 and 4 on Wednesday, 5 and 6 on Thursday, 7 and 8 will be on Friday. Over the course of the next week, teachers will be notifying students of the times that they will be available to work with students for extra help and make-ups. Prior to the exam week, it would be beneficial if each parent would check with their student and the Infinite Campus parent portal to see if there is any missing or late work that is eligible for make-up. Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors will have open campus during exam times as well as the afternoon make-up times. Freshman students are expected to be present for all morning classes, but will have open campus during the afternoon sessions. Quiet study halls will be available during all exam periods and during the make-up time for all students who do not have access to transportation. It is extremely important that students are present and on time for their exams. Late students will not be admitted to exams and, with permission of administration, will be required to attend one of the make-up sessions to complete their exams. All absences and tardies must be for an excused reason in order to make-up exams.

The course registration process for the 2012-2013 school year will be starting at the end of this month. To prepare for and inform students about this process, Student Services and the curriculum leaders will be hosting informational sessions during extended homerooms. The sessions will outline credit requirements, course prerequisites, and electives that are available to each of the grade levels. Final course selections will take place during the first two weeks of February. Detailed information about the sign up process will be sent out from student services at the end of this month.
