Strategies

- Preview text
- Activate and use prior knowledge
- Make and confirm predictions
- Retell stories, including characters, setting, and plot
- Identify main ideas
- Make connections: text to self, text to text, text to world

- Set the purpose for reading
- Recognize story structure

Phonemic Awareness

- Recognize and produce rhyme
- Count syllables in words
- Count words in sentences
- Segment and blend onset rhyme
- Segment a word into sounds
- Blend sounds orally to make words
- Add, delete, or substitute medial sounds in spoken words
- Identify and isolate sounds that are the same or different

Oral Vocabulary

- Develop vocabulary through direct instruction, concrete experiences, reading, and listening to text read aloud
- Use words to describe location, size, color, and shape
- Use new oral vocabulary words in context to reinforce meaning

Phonics

- Know most common sound associated with individual letters
- Blend sounds to decode one-syllable words:
 - *consonants
 - *consonant blends (bl, sp ,pl, etc.)
 - *short vowels
 - *phonograms/word families

Fluency

- Listen to models read aloud with accuracy, comprehension, and appropriate rate
- Read irregular high-frequency words automatically

Writing

- modeled writing
- shared writing
- coached writing
